# AFE77xxD BSDL Guidelines



#### Guidelines

- 1. RESETZ: Pulsed from VSS to IOVDD for > 100ns upon power up.
  - a. If RESETZ is tied to IOVDD upon power-up, the device comes up in an unknown state and the direction of IO pads is unknown.
  - b. To bring up the device to a known state, RESETZ needs to be pulsed from VSS to IOVDD.
- 2. The two pins BIST1 and BIST0 determine the mode of operation. For BSR mode:
  - a. BISTB1: To be tied HIGH.
  - b. BISTB0: To be tied LOW.
- 3. Some of the IOs are not brought out but have BSR cells.
  - a. These are mentioned as linkage and associated with some of the power pads like VDDA.
  - b. Nothing needs to be done for these pins.
- 4. IR width is 8 bits for all instructions.
- 5. The instruction opcodes are as follows:

a. SAMPLE: 0x02b. EXTEST: 0x00c. BYPASS: 0xFFd. IDCODE: 0x01

- 6. 32-bit DR value for IDCODE of the device is as follows:
  - a. MANUFACTURER NUMBER: 11 bits: 0x451

b. PART\_NUMBER: 16 bits: 0x0078c. VERSION\_NUMBER: 4 bits: 0x0d. IDCODE: 32 bits: 0x000788A3

7. Table 1 summarizes the modes of operation of the device using BIST inputs
